



2011 AUDITION REQUIREMENTS & GUIDELINES

- 1 Prepare and label an audition CD or cassette tape of quality that best represents yourself following the guidelines listed below:**
 - include one accompanied art song or aria of choice (no musical theater), not to exceed 5 minutes in length
 - please start recording by stating your name, and the title and composer of your chosen audition piece
 - on an “awe” vowel, record ascending/descending five tone scales (1 2 3 4 5 4 3 2 1) proceeding upwards/downwards by whole steps; begin from mid-range and proceed to top of range, then mid-range down to bottom of range
- 2 Audition CDs or cassette tapes should be accompanied by the 2011 STUDENT APPLICATION FORM.**
- 3 Audition materials should include a headshot, graduation picture, or quality photo of applicant.**
- 4 Applicants understand that the cost of tuition, including room and two meals a day, is \$1,925.00 per person.**
- 5 Applicant audition CD or cassette tape & materials should be sent via mail, UPS or Fed Ex BY NOVEMBER 1, 2010 to:**

- 6 Applicant's college conductor must send the completed recommendation form under separate cover - DO NOT include the recommendation form with the the applicants audition CD & materials.**
- 7 Acceptance into the ensemble will be announced on December 1, 2010.**
- 8 A non-refunable \$500 deposit from accepted participants will then be due in New York by December 15, 2010. An additional 1,000.00 will be due by March 1, 2011. The final payment of 425.00 will be due by May 15, 2011.**
