When not on stage, ensembles have the opportunity to attend performances by other participating bands and orchestras from seats in the audience.

VENUE

Performance at New York City's legendary Carnegie Hall, Isaac Stern Auditorium.

EXPERIENCE

Qualified bands and orchestras receive 22 minutes of solo stage time receiving comments from our faculty, attend performances of other participating ensembles, a private clinic session in host hotel ballroom, and ensemble listing on official concert poster.

CONCERT STAFF

Professional production team handles venue management, advertising, and audience development.

PERCUSSION

Over \$2,000 of rented equipment including: timpani (4 sizes), concert bass drum, concert snare drum, concert chimes, bells, xylophone, vibraphone, marimba, and crash cymbal.

Peter Loel Boonshaft has been invited to speak and conduct in every state in the nation and around the world. Honored by the National Association for Music Education and Music For All as the first recipient of the "George M. Parks Award for Leadership in Music Education," Dr. Boonshaft is Director of Education for Jupiter Band Instruments. He is the author of the critically acclaimed best-selling books *Teaching Music with Passion*, *Teaching Music with Purpose*, and *Teaching Music with Promise*. He is also co-author of Alfred Music's method book series *Sound Innovations*. As well, his weekly "Boonshaft's Blog" for music educators continues to inspire teachers everywhere.

A passionate supporter of composers and the arts of our time, Kevin Noe has commissioned and premiered over 100 new works. Having a background in the theatre from an early age, he has a particular interest in works that blend a variety of art forms and serves regularly as stage director, actor, writer, filmmaker, and conductor for a variety of operatic and theatrical mixed-media productions. He is the Artistic Director of the Pittsburgh New Music Ensemble Theatre of Music. Together with co-creator Kieren MacMillan, Noe wrote, directed, and played the role of Sisyphus in a multi-media work entitled *Just Out of Reach*, a production which was then invited to perform at the festivals in Edinburgh and nominated for a Total Theatre award.
