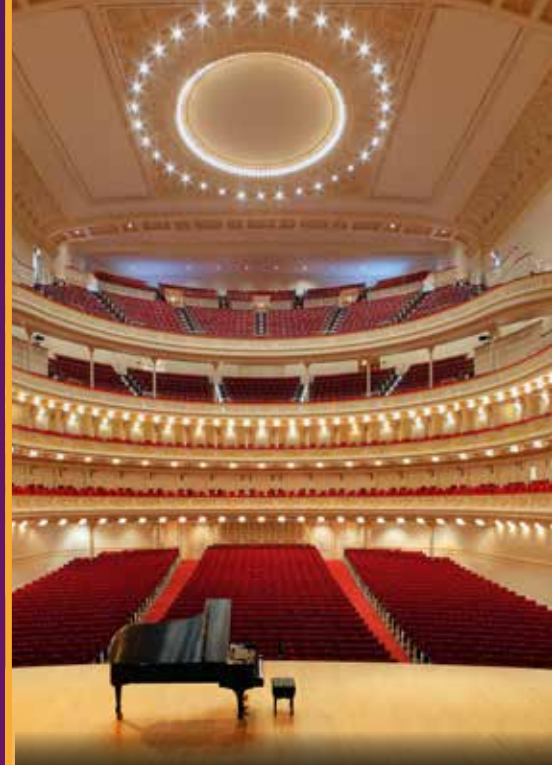


FROM OUR SYMPHONIC SERIES AT CARNEGIE HALL
